Turn RIGHT onto GA-25 Spur, travel 2.3 miles and turn RIGHT on US Highway 17 North/GA-25 N which is the main drag thru Woodbine. Travel 0.5 miles and turn RIGHT onto E 4th Street. Go 0.1 miles and turn left onto Camden Avenue as you are facing the Camden County Courthouse. The Woodbine Opry is located in the Old Woodbine High School on the corner of 2nd Avenue and Camden Avenue in Woodbine.**

FROM JACKSONVILLE, FL & ST. MARYS, GA  
& POINTS SOUTH:

**Travel north on Interstate 95, take Exit 14-Spur 25 exit for Woodbine, GA. Turn LEFT onto GA-25 Spur, travel 2.3 miles and turn RIGHT on US Highway 17 North/GA-25 N which is the main drag thru Woodbine. Travel 0.5 miles and turn RIGHT onto E 4th Street. Go 0.1 miles and turn left onto Camden Avenue as you are facing the Camden County Courthouse. The Woodbine Opry is located in the Old Woodbine High School on the corner of 2nd Avenue and Camden Avenue in Woodbine.**
